



OSRUI Family Camp Frequently Asked Questions

Who is invited to participate in OSRUI's Family Camp?

We welcome prospective camp families, current camp families, alumni, and others who are excited about spending a weekend at camp ... parents/guardians, grandparents, extended family and kids! Children must be accompanied by at least one adult.

What kinds of activities will be part of the weekend?

Family Camp will allow all members of your family to experience the magic of a Shabbat at camp, including a delicious Shabbat dinner and the excitement of Shabbat Shira (song session). Throughout the weekend there will be a variety of sports, arts, games, and other recreational activities, all designed with the needs of families in mind.

Will all activities be for the entire family, or will children and adults have separate programming?

Programming is for parents and children together. Late night Saturday there will be time for adults to socialize (babysitting provided). Also, while we encourage you to participate in as much of what is offered as possible, this should also be a chance for you to relax and recharge. There is a scheduled time for menucha (rest), but feel free to step away from programming and relax anytime.

Where will families be housed during the weekend?

Families are housed in the Daniel M. Soref Education and Alumni Center, the Schaalman Lodge, or the Bayit. The buildings feature rooms with two twin beds and a private bath; a few rooms in the Bayit share a bath with an adjoining room. We can add one or two cots or a crib to your room. The registration fee is for families staying in one room; you can reserve a second, adjacent room for an additional charge.

What is the fee to participate in Family Camp?

The fee is \$550 per family; additional rooms are \$250. This includes lodging, all meals, and all in-camp programming. You can pay via credit card when you register; or pay by check. Make checks payable to OSRUI and mail to: OSRUI Family Camp, 1121 Lake Cook Road, Suite D, Deerfield, IL 60015.
