



## OSRUI Financial Assistance Application

### To Fill Out the Financial Assistance Application, you will need the following:

1. **Sessions** that each camper is registered for.
2. **Annual Income** for each parent/guardian if parents are married. Parents who are divorced should apply separately and only include their own income.
3. **Other Sources of Income** yearly income from social security, child support, etc.
4. **Medical and dental expenses** not paid by insurance during the past year (this does not include premiums)
5. **Monthly rent/mortgage payment**
6. **Personal narrative** – 1-3 paragraphs about why you are requesting partial, need-based financial assistance. You may also upload a Word doc or PDF.
7. **Amount of financial assistance you are requesting/receiving from:**
  - a. Your Congregation
  - b. One Happy Camper
  - c. Your local Federation
  - d. Other funding sources (other organizations, grandparents, etc.)
8. **Total tuition** for all campers (the amounts for each session are provided in the form; you just need to keep track. If you do not belong to a URJ congregation, you'll need the amount you were charged for the non-URJ fee. There's a guide on the form or check your ledger in CampMinder). If parents are divorced and the parent applying for scholarship only pays for a percentage of camp fees, figure out the percentage of the total fees that you are responsible for.
9. **Total cost of transportation** (bus fee, airfare. All campers will need to arrive by bus this year and the cost of \$230 appears on your ledger in CampInTouch. That fee is waived for those flying to Milwaukee airport and those who travel more than 350 miles to camp.)
10. **Parent Contribution** amount you are personally able to pay toward the cost of camp.
11. **PDF of tax forms to be uploaded:**
  - a. Upload pages 1 and 2 of your 2019 U.S. Form 1040 (or your 2020 U.S. Form 1040 if completed)

***Please Note: DO NOT upload your entire tax form; we only need pages 1 and 2.***
