

As you are aware, CDC guidance continues to evolve and change, sometimes daily! Please remember the CDC guidance is generally designed for an individual and their family and not the communal setting of a residential summer camp. Thus, our guidance may at times be slightly more restrictive out of an abundance of caution in protecting the health and safety of our communities.

We require that all summer staff/adult commit to the following:

VACCINATION

- Acquiring your second dose of either the Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Sputnik V, or NOVAVAX vaccine or one dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
 - Fill out all of your forms including your vaccine card form and vaccine card photo

PRE-CAMP PCR TEST

- Taking a PCR test 72 hours before arrival to camp, and sending camp the results prior to arrival
- Immediately informing camp if anyone in your school pod or household tests positive for COVID-19 within the two weeks prior to camp starting

PRE-CAMP QUARANTINE

- Minimizing potential exposure to COVID-19 for the 5 days prior to arriving at camp by doing the following:
 - Remaining at home or within your school pod
 - Wearing a mask that covers both the nose and mouth when outside of the home
 - Maintaining physical distancing
 - Practicing prolific hand washing and sanitizing
 - Avoiding any large gatherings and parties
 - Note: Fully vaccinated staff may attend significant family/life-cycle events that qualify as large gatherings within the 5 day quarantine timeframe if the gathering is compliant with CDC guidelines. Masking of staff member during the gathering is required regardless of local masking policies.
 - Following prescribed travel and transportation parameters shared prior to the camp session, which will include specific details around travel to camp by plane, bus, train, and on-site drop off
