



PACKAGE FREE POLICY

OSRUI has a package free policy.

Many families chose to send their child to OSRUI because of the deep sense of community found here. We believe that camp is a place where each camper feels they are valued and treated equally. We have found that the subject of packages, including who receives them and what is inside, has become an unnecessary source of stress and competition among our campers.

What can I send?

Receiving mail at camp is one of the highlights of a camper's day!

Campers may receive standard, letter-sized envelopes and postcards.

We encourage you to use creative ways of interacting with your camper through standard letters, which can include stickers, folded sheets with word puzzles, or a comic clip. We also offer e-letters through CampMinder.

Mail that arrives outside of the allowed parameters (i.e. larger than a letter- or card-size envelope or requiring additional postage), will be held in the camp office until the end of the session and given to your camper on their Closing Day.

What if my camper forgets something essential?

Please note: we provide toiletries and other essentials at no charge for campers who run out or lose something. Please let your camper know that they should let their counselor know if they have run out of anything essential or need help getting something they forgot. We are happy to help!

Can I send a package on my camper's birthday?

If your child has a birthday at camp this summer, our Camp Care Team will reach out to you before your child's session begins to share birthday celebration options.
